



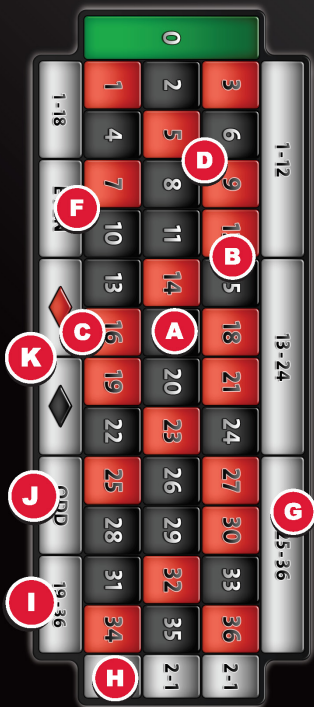
ROULETTE

How To Play

The roulette wheel is marked with the numbers 1 through 36 and the number 0. Numbers are alternately colored red and black, while the 0 is green. The Odds on roulette range from even money to 35 to 1, depending on the wager.

Insert cash or a voucher into the bill acceptor to begin play. Place your bets by selecting the desired chip value from the chip set, and then either touch any bet position on the field or drag the chip to the bet position. When the system announces, **"No more bets, thank you"** you cannot place any additional wagers. For more game information, press the **"Help"** button on the screen.

- A** Single Number (Straight Up) **Pays 35-to-1**
- B** Two Numbers (Split) **Pays 17-to-1**
- C** Three Numbers (Straight Across) **Pays 11-to-1**
- D** Four Numbers **Pays 8-to-1**
- F** Six Numbers Across **Pays 5-to-1**
- G** Dozen (12 Numbers) **Pays 2-to-1**
- H** Column (12 Numbers) **Pays 2-to-1**
- I** 1-to-18 or 19-to-36 **Pays Even Money**
- J** Odd or Even **Pays Even Money**
- K** Color (Red or Black) **Pays Even Money**
